## NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL...

Thank you for another great year with the Starstruck program. I appreciate your support. Starstruck Dance program contracts with us each year to teach our students the dances that they performed. Proceeds from the ticket sales fund the program. A special thanks to our office and custodial staff for their work with all details that ensure that the rehearsals and shows run smoothly.

Grade level teams have been emphasizing common core writing this year, and we are finishing a round of instruction where students went through the writing process to complete an end of unit writing piece. Kindergarten students are working on opinion writing, and their finished project will include an opening statement (provided by the teacher) with three supporting details. By the time students get to fifth grade, their pieces will include opening and closing paragraphs and several supporting paragraphs.

Grade levels meet in December to analyze the students' writing pieces against rubrics designed to address the common core writing standards. Grade levels will be able to determine strengths and needs to determine next steps instructionally to help our students become college and career ready in the area of writing.

The cutoff for AR reading goals (grades 3 - 5) for the second quarter is Friday, December 15th. There is still time to finish that book and take a quiz.

If you are interested in a Starstruck DVD, the last day to turn in your order form is Friday, December 8th. Please drop off your form and payment to the office or with your teacher.

### Cold and Flu Season is here and healthy students are a priority.


#### Following are a few helpful reminders to keep kids cold and flu free this season:

- Teach your children to wash their hands often with soap and water.
- Teach your children not to share personal items such as drinks, food or unwashed utensils and to cover their coughs and sneezes with tissues. Covering up their coughs or sneezes using the elbow, arm or sleeve instead of the hand when a tissue is unavailable.
- Know the signs and symptoms of the flu. Symptoms of the flu include fever (100 degrees or higher), cough, sore throat, a runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headaches, feeling very tired, vomit and diarrhea.
